What Flow?

The approach is called *Tame the Flow* because that it seeks to "tame" the four fundamental flows that determine the overall performance of an organization. The four flows are the following:

Operational Flow

The operational flow is considered as the "workflow" that determines how work moves through the organization. Raw materials are transformed into finished goods. Services are delivered through a succession of steps. Operational flow is measured by means of operational throughput - i.e. the rate at which goods or services are delivered to the market.

• Information Flow

Flow of information that circulates within an organization. It has a deep impact on organizational performance and determines patterns of communication and interaction. Such patterns are the nervous system of an organization, and build its collective intelligence, setting the foundations for the organization's culture, values and principles.

Financial Flow

From an economic perspective, the financial flow is the rate at which the organization turns its products or services into profit. Financial flow is measured in financial throughput and ultimately determines financial performance. Focus on financial flow supports positive management decisions

Emotional Flow

Highest levels performance of individuals or groups are achieved when they reach psychological "flow states." They exhibit a profound and purposeful focus of thought and action towards well identified and clear goals, with complete control over the situation, by all those involved in the performance, even in the face of uncertainty and challenges.
